## **New Business:**

• **Disposition of Surplus Inventory** – We have two 2006 Ford F150 trucks that we no longer use and have met their useful life and purpose and we would like to sell them. One truck we used as a fuel truck (to deliver fuel to the outlying stations for their generators) and the other was used by the Fire

Investigators. Commissioner Ballard asked if we replaced them? No. Commissioner Ballard asked the Attorney if we needed an itemized list to dispose these? No. Commissioner Hoke made a motion to declare the two 2006 Ford F150's (VIN #'s 1756 and 1755) as surplus inventory and allow administration to dispose of them. Seconded by Commissioner Ballard. The motion was put to vote, and approved by the Board. All were in favor. The vote was 5-0.

## **Commissioner Items:**

#### Ballard -

- 1. Two years ago there was an issue with his employment at South Florida Emergency Vehicles and he resigned from there. He explained his employment role there and feels the issue has been resolved. Asked his fellow board members if he could go back to working there as a driver/escort? All agreed they did not have a problem with him being re-employed there. The Board agreed to wait on the Attorney's Opinion, but once received Chief Beecroft could write a letter to South Florida Emergency Vehicles and let the Board know in May the outcome.
